- 2) **What is the duration of B pharmacy Course?**

B Pharmacy Course is for 4 Years after Intermediate/ +2/ XII class

- 3) **What is the duration of Pharm D Course?**

Pharm D Course is for 6 Years after Intermediate/ +2/ XII class

- 4) **What is the duration of Pharm D PB Course?**

Pharm D PB Course is for 3 Years after B Pharmacy.

- 5) **What is the duration of M pharmacy Course?**

M Pharmacy Course is for 2 Years after B Pharmacy

- 6) **Are MPC Students eligible for B pharmacy Course?**

Yes, Students from MPC background in intermediate are eligible for perusing B Pharmacy Course. 50% of Seats are reserved for MPC students and Conveners will allot the seats in the web optins.

- 7) **What are the specializations offered in M pharmacy in this college?**

Presently Malla Reddy college of Pharmacy is Offering 03 Specializations in M Pharmacy Course.

 - M Pharm Pharmaceutics
 - M Pharm Pharmacology

- 8) **What is the difference between B. Pharmacy and Pharm D?**

Both B Pharmacy and Pharm D are the Professional Courses in Pharmacy Education. In practice after completing B Pharm Course the students can practice as pharmacist in industries related to the manufacture and provision of medicines. However, a Pharm D graduate is trained in Pharmacy Practice or Clinical Pharmacy practices under the supervision of Doctors in a Hospital Setup.

- 9) **How can I get an Admission into B. Pharmacy/Pharm D Course in this College?**

After completing Intermediate (MPC or BiPC) and securing Ranks in the entrance examinations conducted by State Govt. (EAMCET and other equivalent examinations) and fulfilling the eligibility criteria, the student can apply for B Pharmacy / Pharm D courses by paying required registration amount for reserving the seat through a counselling and web options. the seats are allotted to the students by Convener

10) How can I get an admission into M. Pharmacy/Pharm D PB course in this college? / Eligibility criteria for Pharm D PB or M Pharm?

After completing B Pharmacy and a better securing Rank in the entrance examinations conducted by Central Govt. (GPAT and other equivalent examination) or State Govt. (PGECET and other equivalent examinations) and fulfilling the eligibility criteria, the student can apply for M Pharmacy / Pharm D PB courses by paying required registration amount for reserving the seat through a counselling and web options. the seats are allotted to the students by Convener.

11) I am non-local to Telangana can i get an admission?

Yes. You are eligible to get an admission in Category B Quota

12) How to get admission on Category b / Eligibility for Management Quota?

30% of seats are filled under Category B it is purely based on the merit at EAMCET for B pharm or Pharm D and intermediate marks. For M Pharm or Pharm D PB GPAT or PGECET Rank

13) Will the college provide EWS category admissions?

Yes, EWS will be made by Convener. Additional 10 % seats are given under EWS quota. EWS quota is purely meant for students whose parental income is less than 8 lakhs per annum.

14) How Can I Apply for The Fee Reimbursement?

In case of Students whose Parental income is less than 1 lakh 50 thousand (Rural) and/or 2 lakhs (Urban) per annum, in case of BC/EBC, 2 lakhs per annum for SC and ST are eligible for Fee Reimbursement. The guidelines for fee reimbursement will be updated by the Govt. of Telangana from time to time. 15) I am non-local to Telangana can i get fee imbursement?

No. Fee reimbursement is given only to Local candidates.

16) What are the accreditations does the college have?

23) What about Housing / Hostel Accommodation?

Malla Reddy Group of Institutions (MRGI) provides hostel accommodation for female students with all standards, civic amenities and common cooking and laundry areas. You should submit your request as soon as possible, because requests are processed on a first-come, first-serve basis, and rooms fill up quickly.
